Welcome to Kindergarten! My name is Mrs. Carey, and I will be your classroom teacher. I am looking forward to a busy and exciting year in our room! As the summer comes to a close and the store shelves begin to fill with school supplies, please keep in mind this suggested supply list for the kindergarten year of school:

- **1 2-pocket folder**
- **1 pack of dry erase markers** (fine tip works best)
- **2 8-packs of washable markers**
- **1 pack of watercolor paints** (8 colors)
- **3 boxes of crayons** (24 count)
- **3 packs of regular #2 pencils** (Ticonderoga brand...please)
- **1 pair of youth scissors**
- **1 backpack**
- **2 packages bottles of Elmer's glue**
- **1 large eraser**
- **1 box of Ziploc bags** (gallon size)
- **3 packages of Graham crackers**
- **1 package of colored pencils**

Our classroom uses community supplies, so please do not label your child's supplies before you bring them. If for some reason you are not able to get your supplies right away there is usually a need about midyear, and you are more than welcome to bring them then.

Either Ms. Eckman (our school secretary) or myself will be contacting you in the month of August to set up a meet and greet for the week of August 26th. During this time, parents and students will be given a school tour, and you will have the opportunity to drop off supplies. I will be reviewing the kindergarten curriculum, and students will be given a brief assessment. Parents will have the opportunity to answer any questions at this time.
